Thank you for your prayers during the past three months. We have seen the Lord bless while presenting our burden to plant a church in Durazno, Uruguay. We have been thrilled to be able to preach and see God's people respond to His message. Pastors have graciously opened their ministries, and God's people have been wonderful in providing excellent hospitality.

A joy of traveling to various ministries is the privilege of seeing friends whom we have not visited in quite some time. They are often able to share some tidbit of our parent's ministries in the past that has been a blessing to them, and that now is a wonderful memory for us. In seeking to be a blessing to those around us, we have been blessed immensely as well.

Since we last wrote, we have been to the Heart Conference at Northland Baptist Bible College; to our former extension church in Escanaba, Michigan; to a family seminar in Decatur, Alabama; to a meeting in Benson, Illinois; to a church in the Twin Cities, and to a Round Robin Conference in Southwestern Minnesota and Northwestern Iowa. In addition, the Lord has given us several new meetings for this year and some for the beginning of 2006. Praise the Lord for the safety He has given us in travel, for health, especially for Felicia, and for the opportunity to share our ministry.

While the Lord is continuing to open the door for us to leave for Uruguay, we gradually see Him closing the door on our secular jobs. Please pray that the Lord will allow us to reach at least 35 percent support by this fall. This will enable us to travel full time without being held back by a secular job.

Finally, the Lord has blessed us with the addition of yet another individual supporter. We are currently at eighteen percent support. Please pray as we seek to reach hearts concerning missions in Uruguay.
