Dear Praying Friends,

Happy July 4th! We trust this letter finds you rejoicing in the freedoms that the Lord grants us as we live in this beautiful country. Since our last letter, we have been in six churches. We attended a week of evangelistic meetings hosted by our church and went to our final week of BWM orientation. In order to make contacts, I attended the Men for Christ rally and the New Testament Association meeting. We also attended an evangelism seminar, which completed our four weeks of training for the mission.

We count it a special privilege to be able to present our burden for Uruguay in churches across the Midwest. We have seen several folks encouraged in their walk with the Lord and some challenged to work harder in their own personal mission fields. These results have been uplifting to us. We are currently at 25% support. In addition, two churches are seriously considering supporting us. **Please pray**, that the Lord will continue to allow us to find churches with receptive hearts that are in geographically close areas.

In an effort to keep you, our supporters, more up to date with our ministry, **we have built a new website**. One pastor told me that the only webs he knows are the ones in the corner of the barn! Having said that, he was glad to be able to know how our ministry is progressing. One colleague asked me two weeks ago about my home in Heaven.

You ask, "Where were we last week?" Last week we were attending a seminar sponsored by Baptist World Mission at Marquette Manor Baptist Church in Chicago. Pastor Jeff Musgrave from Colorado has developed a soul-winning method entitled "Jesus Is the Answer." This method helps present the heart of the Gospel in a complete, yet concise, fashion and emphasizes the sufficiency of Scripture. **Please pray** that the Lord will help us turn conversations with the lost to the Theme of themes.

While at the evangelism seminar, we received word from Uruguay that Jo Anna's sister, Carolyn, had an appendectomy. Although the appendix was perforated, she is recovering nicely. She is the pastor's wife of a growing church in the city of Paysandu. **Please pray** that this national work will continue to see excellent progress. Within the past month several young folks have been baptized.
